



What to bring for PraiseWorks

- Bible
- Pen or Pencil
- Instrument for orchestra members
- Bedding, Pillow, Blanket
- Towels, Washcloth
- Toiletries
- Jeans for Friday performance – NO SHORTS CAN BE WORN ON FRIDAY.
- Money for snacks, ice cream shop, OBU bookstore (no big bills, bring rolls of quarters for vending machines)
- Cell phone (must be off during all rehearsals, tracks, and worship)
- Talent Show Music, Accompaniment, Props, etc. (must sign up for talent show on registration form)

FOR TRACKS

- Guitar needed for all levels of guitar tracks –Advanced Level prefers an electric guitar with small amp.
- Drama – Bring an all black outfit
- Drum Classes – Drumsticks needed (preferably 5A or 7A).
- Interpretive Movement – Black pants, solid color shirt (any color), black socks or black jazz shoes.
- Photography – Camera required. An iPhone will work, but is not ideal because you can't manipulate it and learn to be creative!
- Piano – Advanced – Bring a favorite hymn or worship song to play.
- Sign Language – Bring a solid black t-shirt for Tracks on Display.
- Tech, Sound, Lighting – Please do not repeat the same level of this class if you have taken it previously.
- Evening Worship Choir – Must have Minister of Music recommendation.

What to wear for the week

- Modest shorts are fine for the morning and afternoon. Jeans, long pants, capris, dresses, skirts are preferred for night, but shorts are still acceptable (shorts @ fingertip length).
- No sleeveless or cold shoulder clothing, no skinny straps, wife beaters, tank tops, negative logos or messages, and no exposed midriff area.

Important Information for the week!

- Wear your name badge at all times around your neck. It serves as your meal ticket, contains a small schedule.

- ALL PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS WILL BE KEPT IN THE CAMP OFFICE AND ADMINISTERED BY THE CAMP MEDICAL PERSONNEL. THIS IS A CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS YEARS. No prescription medications are to be kept in the dorm.
- Cell phones may not be used in any class, rehearsal or worship.

Students will . . .

- Recognize authority of PW's leadership (faculty and sponsors).
- Participate in all tracks, rehearsals and worship. All students will be a part of choir or orchestra.
- Dress appropriately according to the camp guidelines.
- Sleep in their assigned room.

- Clear their table in the dining hall and not litter the campus.

Students are not. . .

- Allowed to stay in their rooms alone during the day under any circumstances. If you are sick, a sponsor must stay with you and the camp office must be alerted.
- Allowed to show public displays of affection.

Students may not. . .

- Leave OBU campus without permission from PW office.
- Have knives, other weapons, fireworks, illegal substances, tobacco, or alcohol products in their possession. Vaping is not allowed.
- Leave the dorm after lights out.
- Go into each other's dorms.
- Go down by the river in the Gazebo area.

Students are issued keys and dorm cards. If lost, your church will be charged \$25 per key and \$10 per card. Any act of vandalism against OBU will be charged to your church. Dorm rooms that are not clean will be charged a \$40.00 dirty room charge by Ouachita.

Please alert any parents or others from your church who may visit the camp that they are required to check in and provide a current ID (driver's license, etc.)
